

Rules and Regulations

Obtaining the diploma

- To obtain the executive diploma in Data Science, Deep Learning, and AI solutions, the participant should reach the minimum **Diploma Total Score (DTS) of 60 over 100**.
- A DTS between 85 over 95 will accredit the participant with an "Excellent" grade, and a "Distinguished" one if 95 and above.
- A DTS below 60 over 100 obliges the participant to pass further assignments to get the diploma.
- Top 5 students have the priority of **guaranteed recruitment by AI Ventures in Dubai** at graduation.

2. Grading a Course CTS

Each **Course Total Score (CTS)** is jointly subject to both Quiz Grade, Project Grade, and Presence Grade (10 points by default). Quiz Grade represents 60% of the CTS and Project Grade the remaining 30%. The two lowest CTS are excluded from the DTS.

2.1. The "Quiz" Grade

- Each course is subject to 6 graded quizzes, 15 points each.
- Top 4 grades are retained out of the 6 and the 2 minimum ones are excluded, making the course Knowledge Grade up to 60 points.

2.2. The "Project" Grade

- At the end of each course, 2 projects are mandatory to deliver, most of them SAS and Python projects, but could be as well Microsoft Azure, Oracle, etc.
- Each project is graded 15 points, totaling 30 points for each CTS.
- Last course includes one project only graded 30 points

2.3. The "Presence" Grade

- By default, each course is granted 10 points on the presence, of which 2 points are removed at each absence from any session.
- 8 absences and above considers the course as dropped.

2.4. Cancelled CTS

- Lowest two CTS are excluded from the DTS.

3. Mid-Term

- The Mid-Term exam falls at the end of the 6th course and represents 15% of the DTS.

4. Final Project

- The Final Project represents 25% of the DTS and a minimum grade of 60 over 100 is mandatory.

5. Dropping Credits

- The total program is made up of 10 courses, each of 3 credits totaling 30 credits.
- Each participant has the right to drop 6 credits of his/her own choice from the total 30 credits.
- In the case of dropping only one credit from a course, its two related quiz grades will be considered equivalent to the 2 minimum ones that were to be excluded by default from the CTS.
